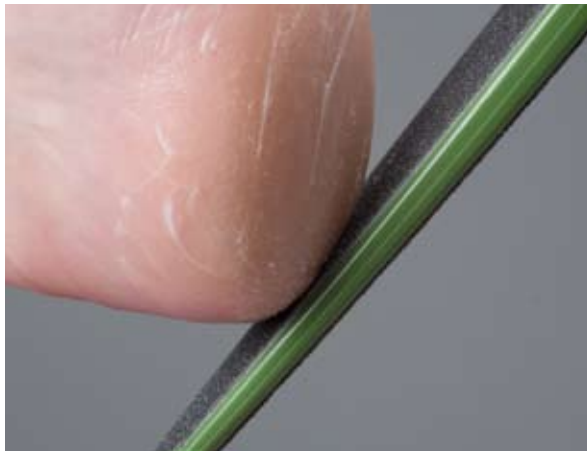
Dr. G's Antimicrobial Callus & Cuticle Remover



1 Soak the client's feet in a pedicure tub. Dry feet and apply Dr. G's Callus and Cuticle Remover to calloused feet.

3 Gently file calluses with a foot file or pumice stone.



4 Rinse skin thoroughly and continue with pedicure as usual.

2 Apply Essie First Base base coat.



3 Apply two coats of Essie lacquer in Red Nouveau.
